aug 12 2022 daniel defoe a hero for all times 1660 1731 12th august 2022 daniel defoe s life was as packed with adventure as that of any storybook hero including the eponymous hero of the novel robinson crusoe but defoe was real he was the world s first realistic novelist a fearless political campaigner the world s first campaigning and investigative journalist and the publisher of one of the world s first newspapers daniel defoe orig daniel

foe born 1660 london eng died april 24 1731 london british novelist pamphleteer and journalist a well educated london merchant he became an acute economic theorist and began to write eloquent witty often audacious tracts on public affairs jan 1 2023 daniel defoe born 1660 london eng died april 24 1731 london english novelist pamphleteer and journalist author of robinson crusoe 1719 22 and moll flanders 1722 early life defoe s father james foe was a hard working and fairly prosperous tallow chandler perhaps also later a butcher of flemish descent apr 2 2014 daniel defoe became a merchant and participated in several failing businesses facing bankruptcy and aggressive creditors he was also a prolific political pamphleteer which landed him in prison a journal of the plague year being observations or memorials of the most remarkable occurrences as well publick as private which happened in london during the last great visitation in 1665 commonly called a journal of the plague year is a book by daniel defoe first published in march 1722 it is an account of one man s

experiences of the year 1665 in which the bubonic plague struck the city of london in what became known as the great plague of english writer journalist and poet daniel defoe was the first of the great eighteenth century english novelists he wrote more than five hundred books pamphlets articles and poems education marriage and early career little is known about the birth and early childhood of daniel defoe as no baptism record exists for him defoe became a merchant but went bankrupt in 1692 and left the world of business in 1703 defoe was an acclaimed and prolific pamphleteer and journalist who wrote scabrous attacks on supporters of king william iii and queen anne william s successor defoe was often imprisoned for his inflammatory writings defoe was probably born in london or just outside of the city in 1660 to a family of presbyterian dissenters he was educated at a dissenting academy in newington green he became a merchant dealing in different commodities including hosiery in 1684 he married mary tuffley 1665 1732 six of their eight children lived into adulthood

defoe s range is narrow but within that range he is a novelist of considerable power and his plain direct style as in almost all of his writing holds the reader s interest in 1724 he published his last major work of fiction roxana though in the closing years of his life despite failing health he remained active and enterprising as a writer daniel defoe d ? ? f o? born daniel foe c 1660 24 april 1731 was an english writer merchant journalist pamphleteer social critic and spy he is most famous for his novel robinson crusoe published in 1719 which is claimed to be second
